Vilas County Public Health Department is Offering Flu Vaccines

Respiratory Illness Season is upon us. The Vilas County Public Health Department (VCPHD) will be offering the seasonal influenza vaccines. The VCPHD will offer a Trivalent (all ages) flu shot for \$55.00 and High Dose (65 years and older) for \$97.00. We now have the ability to bill most private insurances. We encourage any flu clinic participants to pre-register by calling 715-479-3656 and bring insurance cards on the day of the event.

Everyone 6 months of age and older should get vaccinated against the flu. People at high risk of serious flu complications include young children, pregnant women, people with chronic health conditions like asthma, diabetes or heart and lung disease, and people 65 years and older.

Please take the following precautions to protect your health:

- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth. Germs can spread this way.

In partnership with our community, Vilas County Public Health Department creates individual and family resilience by promoting health, creating safe environments, and improving quality of life across the lifespan. • Stay home if you are sick until at least 24 hours after you no longer have a fever (100°F or 37.8°C) or signs of a fever (without the use of a fever-reducing medicine).

The cost of the Trivalent (all ages) flu shot is \$55.00. The cost of the High Dose- (65 and older) flu shot is \$97.00. These are payable in cash or check. We will bill Medicare Part B and most private insurances. If you have any questions about accepted insurance, please pre-register by calling 715-479-3656. There are some restrictions. All clinics are subject to vaccine supply.
